

DPMMS AVID

The AVID Elective is a 6th through 12th grade component of the AVID Secondary System that prepares students in the academic middle for admission to a four-year college or university. Students take an AVID course throughout middle school and high school that provides them with the skills needed to be successful in advancing academically with the ultimate goal of attending college. For more than 30 years, AVID has been instrumental in preparing students for success in higher education.

The core component of the AVID Secondary System is the AVID class, which supports students as they challenge themselves in more rigorous classes. Every AVID student must participate in at least one Advance Academic Course each year they are a member of the AVID Elective. Students are taught study skills, note-taking, time management, writing skills, and research skills while being immersed in a college-going culture. The class also includes weekly tutoring sessions that are led by teachers, peers, or college students and provide support for success in the academically rigorous curriculum. Additionally, the AVID class provides access to information about colleges and universities through field trips, guest speakers, college tutors, scholarship opportunities, and college admission requirement information.

Application process:

- Students submit their online application
- Teachers submit recommendation forms
- Students participate in student interviews.
